Remaining parts of the syllabuses have to be introduced. According to AICTE norms, New syllabi have been executed from 2018-19 session.

21 Days induction program for the first year students executed. Arranged special lectures in Yoga, Social Activist, Alumnus, Red cross Society Jalpaiguri, Industrial visit Student related extracurricular activities have been arranged to satisfy the Mandatory Additional Requirements. Prof. Roychowdhury explained about induction program. Honourium of Rs.500/day paid to Yoga trainer and this amount may be extended to other trainers. Principal explained about the Mandatory Additional Requirements to earn the B.Tech. degree.

**Proceedings:** Members exchanged their views on report regarding the remaining parts of the syllabuses. Discussion held for further course of action are to be taken in this regard.
