Policy for Students with Disabilities

I. Introduction

This policy document outlines the commitment of Jalpaiguri Govt. II. Policy Statement

Jalpaiguri Govt. Engineering College is committed to the following principles:

Non-discrimination: Students with disabilities will be admitted, treated, and evaluated based solely on their academic qualifications and abilities.

Reasonable Accommodations: We will provide reasonable accommodations to ensure equal access to educational programs, activities, and services.

III. Procedures

A. Admissions

- * Documentation from a qualified professional is required to determine eligibility for accommodations.
- * Admissions decisions will be based on academic qualifications, not disability.

B. Accommodations

- * A dedicated office (e.g., Disability Services Office) will coordinate the provision of accommodations.
- * Students will work with the office to determine appropriate accommodations based on their individual needs.
- * Examples of accommodations may include:
 - * Extended time on exams
 - * Alternative testing formats
 - * Accessible course materials
 - * Assistive technology
 - * Note-taking services
 - * Modified classroom arrangements

C. Accessibility

- * Accessible communication formats will be provided for all documents and announcements.

D. Faculty and Staff Training

- * Faculty and staff will receive training on:

 - * Accessible communication strategies

E. Grievance Procedure

- * Students who feel their needs are not being met can file a grievance with the designated office.
- * A fair and impartial process will be followed to address any concerns.
