#### Minutes:

The Chairman welcomed the members present in the meeting and requested the Coordinator to start the discussion as per the agenda.

### 20.1: Confirmation of minutes of the 19th IQAC meeting

Proceedings: IQAC coordinator read the minutes of the 19th meeting.

Resolution: Members confirmed the minutes.

## 20.2: ATR report w.r.t 19th meeting

Proceedings: IQAC coordinator placed A.T.R.

Resolution: Members accepted A.T.R. with satisfaction.

#### 20.3: Academic Audit Committee

Proceedings: As the first step in establishing an Academic Audit Committee, a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the academic audit was drafted and sent to other institutes for feedback. Both the SOP and the feedback received were presented to the committee.

Resolution: The committee members reviewed the SOP and unanimously agreed to proceed with its implementation.

### 20.4: CAS promotions:

Proceedings: The CAS proposal of Dr. Anup Dey was presented for review.

Resolution: The committee approved Dr. Anup Dey's CAS proposal for further processing. Members also raised concerns about the pending CAS promotion cases and resolved to take appropriate action to address the issue.

#### 20.5: Publication of results

Proceedings: The records concerning the publication of the even semester 2024 results were presented. The results for the 8th semester were released just 15 days after the exams, while the results for the 2nd, 4th, and 6th semesters were published within 35 days. For the first time, the analysis of the 8th semester results was conducted using bar charts and pie charts for the academic years 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24.
